Appearance: "Nzinu," a white wine produced with the Malvasia grape, appears in the glass with a bright and luminous straw yellow color. This shade evokes the Salento sun and promises a fresh and lively tasting experience.

Smell: Exploring the aromatic bouquet of "Nzinu" reveals delicate and inviting aromas. Hints of white flowers emerge, such as jasmine and acacia, which dominate with elegance, giving a sensation of spring in the bottle. Notes of fresh fruit, such as green apple and orange, add a natural sweetness and lively freshness. A light touch of aromatic herbs, such as mint and basil, contributes to a light and pleasant aromatic complexity.

Taste: The palate is enveloped by a sensation of freshness and lightness. "Nzinu" offers a light and supple structure, with a lively acidity that gives vitality to the wine. The taste is dominated by fresh and crunchy fruit, with a natural sweetness that recalls the fragrance of the sense of smell. The finish is clean and slightly spicy, with an underlined note of aromatic herbs and citrus fruits, which invites another sip.

Culinary pairings: "Nzinu" is an ideal white wine to accompany light and fresh dishes. It pairs beautifully with summer salads, fish-based dishes such as grilled swordfish or prawn carpaccio, and fresh cheeses such as buffalo mozzarella. It is also an excellent choice for outdoor aperitifs and informal evenings with friends.
