



HOREB CHIANTI DOCG 13,5%

(Ebr. Hōrēb) In the Bible, the mountain on which Moses has various theophanies and promulgates the law of the Jews.

The name seems to be synonymous with Sinai and it is likely that the use of one or the other depends on the different sources in which it appears. it is in Horeb that the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire in the middle of a bush. He looked and behold: the bush was burning in the fire, but that bush was not consumed.

wine obtained from the organic cultivation of Sangiovese grapes. A wine of great olfactory richness; notes of red fruit are perceived, complemented by pleasant spicy notes.

The colour is ruby red, tending to garnet with age. The wine has a good softness, the sip is fresh and long. A wine for every meal, it goes well with the classic Florentine steak grilled, roast pork, or pot roasts.
